Declaration of Compliance

We confirm that the article/-s we supply to Uniol Produkter AB meets the *EU regulations for materials, plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with food: 10/2011, 1935/2004 and 2023/2006.*

Emballator Mellerud Plast AB adds no further additives beyond plastics and masterbatch (color pigment) in the process. The articles are free from Bisphenol A and Phtalates. All included components in the articles are approved according to *the REACH regulation 1907/2006.*

Migration test are performed according to 10/2011. We have tested with following food simulants:

- 3% acetic acid in dest water (food simulant B)
- 10% ethanol in dest water (food simulant A)
- 20% ethanol in dest water (food simulant C)
- 50% ethanol in dest water (food simulant D1)
- Olive Oil (food simulant D2)

The area of use for these food simulants are listed in EU directive 10/2011, Annex III Food Simulants Article 3, Table 2.

Overview areas of use:

- Beverages, clear and cloudy (for example water, cider, juice, syrups)
- Alcoholic beverages with an alcoholic strength up to 20% vol
- Fats and oils
- Animal products and eggs
- Milk products
- Confectionery products, sugar and sugar products in paste or liquid form
- Fruit in the form of purée, preserves, pastes or in its own juice or in sugar syrup. Fruit preserved in a liquid medium. Nuts in paste or cream form
- Processed vegetables in the form of purée, preserves, and pastes or in its own juice. Preserved vegetables in liquid medium
- Miscellaneous – for example vinegar, sauces, mustards

Certificate is valid as long as the directives we are referring to is valid. Changes in certificate will not be notified.
